It is turned on a lathe and polished until it is a smooth hollow cylinder that fits perfectly in your hand. Then a seam ripper is inserted into one end and a stiletto into the other. Pull them out and turn them around and you are ready to work. Turn them back around to store them inside. Two tools in one. Dennis also has gorgeous woodturned pens and peppermills.

Wynter Haven Quilt Studio, Queensbury NY - Did you want one of their great fabric kits but haven't had a chance to go to Queensbury lately? You are in luck because Jill & Pat White will be here - at our show. They will have a large selection of modern fabrics, Adirondack fabrics, kits and specialty rulers.
