"Origami Hexi Handbag" – supplies list

For the January 16th, 2016 WQG in-house workshop with Anna Wang

Please bring following supplies to the workshop

- One yard of quilt quality fabric This will be on both the outside and the inside of your finished handbag. Select fabric that is on the sturdier side, can be creased easily, and can hold the crease. Avoid fabric that is flimsy.
- Half a yard of batting Batting of medium or high loft is more suitable for this project. Avoid batting that is too thin or too thick.
- Template plastic (measured 81/2" by 11") and appropriate cutter
- Fabric marker (coordinate with your choice of fabric)
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat (measured 18" by 24")
- Rulers with 60 degree marking line one rectangle (measured 6" by 24") and one square (measured 6¹/₂" by 6¹/₂")
- Hand sewing/quilting needles
- Regular sewing thread (for basting folded fabric edges in place when making the origami hexi's)
- Hand quilting thread (coordinate with your choice of fabric)
- Pins
- Thread snipers
- Stiletto, i.e. straight tailor's awl (wooden skewer works too)
- **Glue stick** (non toxic, washable, acid free)
- Threader (optional)
- Thimble (optional)
- One handbag handle (measured 13" in length and ~1" in width, purchased or make your own), two buckles, and two swivel hooks (coordinate in size and color with the finished handbag)
- Embellishment items of your choice (coordinate with your choice of fabric) Covered buttons, color/novelty buttons, glass/crystal beads, rhinestones, ribbon flowers, embroidery floss, etc.

We will not be using sewing machine during this in-house workshop.
