Registration Instructions:

- * You must submit a separate completed registration form for **each** item entered in the show. Multiple forms can be submitted in the same envelope as long as it is mailed with sufficient postage.
- * Your entry forms must be received by Saturday, August 27, 2016.
- * Registration check made payable to Wiltwyck Quilters Guild must accompany your entry forms.
WQG Members: \$6.00 for each quilt to be Judged, \$4.00 for each Display only quilt
Non-Members: \$8.00 for each quilt to be Judged, \$6.00 for each Display only quilt
- * A printed **photograph** for each entry **MUST** accompany the entry form (no slide or digital format, please). Do not staple anything to the registration form.
- * Include a signed appraisal by a certified appraiser verifying quilt's value if you wish to establish the value as being higher than the allotted insurance (see below).
- * Include one self-addressed, stamped business size envelope with your registration forms.
- * Your signature is required on all quilt registration forms.

Requirements:

- * Quilts must have at least a 4" sleeve on the back for hanging.
- * No framed pieces will be allowed.
- * Quilts must be in good condition and clean (free of dirt, threads, pet hairs, etc.).
- * Quilts made from kits that include fabric & pattern, antique quilts, or non-quilted wearables will not be judged.
- * You may not enter more than two items in one single judged category. This excludes Display only entries.
- * WQG reserves the right to limit number of quilts entered due to space limitations.
- * In order for the quilt to be judged, it must have been made by the entrant.
- * A muslin "quilt number" label will be sent to you with your registration receipt. This label is to be sewn to the bottom right hand corner on the quilt back. More information will be sent with your receipt.
- * The guild will not be responsible for any breakable embellishments that you may have on your quilt (for example, glass beads, feathers, etc.).

WQG will provide the following "Standard Insurance Coverage" for your entry:

- * \$600.00 for quilts 70" and greater on the shortest side
- * \$300.00 for quilts less than 70" and greater than 24" on the shortest side
- * \$150.00 for quilts 24" or less on the shortest side and wearables

If you desire more than "Standard Coverage," please be certain to include your quilt on your homeowner's policy or to secure additional insurance through your insurance agent.

Registrars and the quilt show chairs have the right to place quilts in the correct category if they have been incorrectly registered by the quilter. For any questions about your registration, call Shirley Swenson at (845) 876-2556 or Joan Polakoff at (845) 876-5875.

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Category Descriptions for Judged Quilts

Deadline: August 27, 2016

Quilting: Hand – All quilting done by hand. **Machine Quilting on Stationery Machine by Maker** – Machine does not move while being used by maker of the quilt top. **Machine Quilting on Track-Mounted Machine by Maker** – Machine moves while being used by maker of the quilt top. **Paid Machine Quilting** – Quilting done by a paid professional.

Sizes: Small – Perimeter of quilt is less than 150”. Does not include miniature quilts (see below). **Medium** - Perimeter of quilt is 150” or larger but less than 300”. **Large** - Perimeter of quilt is 300” or larger.

Pieced: Piecing predominates by at least 80% over other techniques in amount or effect.

Appliqué: Appliqué predominates by at least 80% over other techniques in amount or effect.

Mixed: A quilt where a fairly even amount of both piecework and appliqué is used to develop the design of the top. Could include additional techniques, such as embroidery, painting, beading, and so forth.

Pictorial: A quilt that represents a recognizable image of a person, place, or thing; any size.

Art/Innovative Quilt: Your original design reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, theme or subject matter, and/or materials. No commercial patterns or copies of previous works. Quilts must be made of fabric, have three layers, and contain quilting. A quilt based on traditional patterns and designs should be entered in another category.

Miniature Quilt: Not just a small quilt, but a replica of a full size quilt with all pieces and blocks in the quilt reduced proportionally to a smaller size. Pieces are usually no larger than 1” to 1-1/2”. The longest side of the quilt is no more than 24” and usually smaller.

Other: A quilt where one special technique or material is used to develop the design of the top such a whole cloth (with or without trapunto), surface design, yoyo, crazy quilt, cathedral window, tied, embroidered, painted, beaded, wool, silk, and so forth. Unquilted entries may be judged but will **not** be considered for Best of Show awards.

Group Quilt: A quilt that has three or more people involved in its completion. Any techniques may be used in the quilt, and it may be quilted by a person other than the makers of the top.

Youth Quilt: A quilt made by someone aged 16 or younger with little or no help from an adult.

Home Furnishings: Table runners, tree skirts, table toppers, bed runners, and so forth

Beginner Quilt Adult: First quilt made by an adult.

Quilted Clothing: Must be quilted. Clothing is not eligible for Best of Show award.

Display Category: Quilts that are not being judged, only displayed.
