
All WQG meetings are held at the Grace Community Church. The coffee, tea and snack begin at 9:30. The meeting begins at 10:00.

For the nursing home: please plan for an adult, both female and male. NO Batting NO heart!!! Just a top and a backing. Lite weight corduroy or flannel. The size should be about 36-38" wide and about 48" long. Not too wide as they can get caught in the wheelchair wheels. Community service sewing is the Wednesday AFTER the regular meeting. Community service sewing is held at the Kingston Elks Lodge, 143 Hurley Ave., Kingston, at 9:00 until noon.



### **CMQHOF 2017 Call for Inductee Nomination:**

Every other year nominations are accepted for induction to the CMQHOF. The application deadline is May 1, 2017. Any number of candidates can be nominated, but at most only 5 will be inducted. At the time of induction, they must reside in Delaware, Greene, Schoharie, Sullivan or Ulster County. Samples of their work will need to be submitted and judging will take place June 26, with the induction ceremony planned for September 30. Pat Clark will have forms at the April meeting, and they will also be posted on our website under the "Members Only" page.

### **CMQHOF Community Service Project – Bags**

The annual project idea this year is bags. Wiltwyck can donate completed bags to the Poughkeepsie Children's Home. No particular size requirement, and making a regular tote bag, like a grocery tote, is fine. A half yard of fabric gives you enough for seam allowance and handles. Upholstery fabric makes beautiful, unlined bags. If you are using cotton fabric, they really do need to be lined which needs another half yard of coordinating fabric. On some, we used webbing strips for handles. It's a good clean out your stash' project.


Pat Clark is the liaison for the CMQHOF Community Service Project - bags.


Everyone is welcome to sign up for individual months if you're interested in collecting fabrics of the established theme.

Fabric cut for the squares should be pre-washed, without selvages. Squares should be cut precisely 6 1/2" by 6 1/2", so that they can be readily used. The colors/themes will be different every month.

Unless called for, please don't use novelty fabrics. The squares will fit nicely into a one-quart Ziploc- type baggie, so please bring one with your name on it. Place your squares on top, and we will distribute your fabric and return your baggie to you filled with all the different fabrics!
