Class Description

Learn a technique to add to your tool belt: brick-by-brick improvisation, my favorite planned improvisation technique using right and straight angles. We'll also discuss ways to vary up your piecing with neutrals, develop a color story, quilting suggestions, and more. Bring your scraps and get ready to sew!

Materials Students Bring to Class

This is an improvisation and fabric play class, so it's difficult to give you exact fabric requirements. Get ready to play and have fun with your scraps!

- An assortment of 25-30 strips of different fabrics or scraps, **precut** between 2" x 6" wide (length can vary)
- 6-8 strips or scraps of **contrasting** fabric, **precut** between 2" – 6" wide (length can vary) – I recommend a neutral like white, gray, or black, unless your other fabrics are neutrals
- Colored pencils and graph paper for design (optional)
- Sewing machine and cords
- Thread and full bobbin
- Rotary cutter and ruler
- Cutting mat
- Pins
- Fabric and thread scissors
