

Sew-Together BAG

The bag looks best with multi colored fabrics as the sample.



The exterior should be quilted any way you like prior to coming to the workshop. The angle for the side panels will be cut at the class

Supplies:

Thread to blend with the binding fabric. Sewing machine that has a zipper foot and a 1/4 " foot or regular foot for straight stitching. Extra needles.

Exterior Fabric: 1 fat quarter (18" x 22")

Lining Fabric: ½ yard x WOF

Pocket Lining: 1/3x WOF

Binding Fabric: 1 fat quarter (18" x 22")

½ yard fusible lightweight interfacing

1 18"x 22" piece of batting or fusible fleece for quilting the outside piece

Zippers -One 18" zipper, Three 9" zippers

Pre-class Instructions:

Exterior: Cut 1: 13 ½ x 9 ¾

Cut 1 piece cotton batting 13 ½ x 9 ¾

Side pieces: Cut 2 pair: each pair 3 7/8 x 14 ¼ Cut 2 matching pair fusible web; iron on

Linings: Cut 4: 8 ¾ x 9 ¾ Cut four matching pieces and iron on

3 Pockets: Cut 2 of each: 4" x 9 ¾

Bindings/Tabs : cut 2 pieces: 2 ¼ x 20" -goes across the top by the zipper

" : 2 ¼ x 6 ¼- tabs on the side

" : 2 ¼ x 15-side panels
