Category Descriptions for Judged Quilts

Deadline: August 25, 2018

Quilting: Hand – All quilting done by hand. **Quilted on Stationery Machine by Maker** – Machine does not move while being used by maker of the quilt top. **Quilted on Track-Mounted Machine by Maker** – Machine moves while being used by maker of the quilt top, who is not a paid professional. **Machine Quilted by Professional** – Quilting done by a paid professional or by maker who is a paid professional quilter.

Sizes: Small/Medium – Perimeter of quilt is less than 300”. Does not include miniature quilts (see below).

Large - Perimeter of quilt is 300” or larger. For “Quilted by Machine Professional” category, see the Wiltwyckquilters.org Web site for sizes.

Pieced: Piecing predominates by at least 80% over other techniques in amount or effect.

Appliqué: Appliqué predominates by at least 80% over other techniques in amount or effect.

Mixed: A quilt where a fairly even amount of both piecwork and appliqué is used to develop the design of the top. Could include additional techniques, such as embroidery, painting, beading, and so forth.

Pictorial: A quilt that represents a recognizable image of a person, place, or thing; any size.

Art/Innovative Quilt: Your original design reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, theme or subject matter, and/or materials. No commercial patterns or copies of previous works. Quilts must be made of fabric, have three layers, and contain quilting. A quilt based on traditional patterns and designs should be entered in another category.

Miniature Quilt: Not just a small quilt, but a replica of a full-size quilt with all pieces and blocks in the quilt reduced proportionally to a smaller size. Pieces are usually no larger than 1” to 1-1/2”. The longest side of the quilt is no more than 24” and is usually smaller.

Other: A quilt where one special technique or material is used to develop the design of the top such as whole cloth (with or without trapunto), surface design, yoyo, crazy quilt, cathedral window, tied, embroidered, painted, beaded, wool, silk, and so forth. Unquilted entries may be judged but will **not** be considered for Best of Show awards.

Group Quilt: A quilt that has three or more people involved in its completion. Any techniques may be used in the quilt, and it may be quilted by a person other than the makers of the top.

Youth Quilt: A quilt made by someone aged 16 or younger with little or no help from an adult.

Home Furnishings: Table runners, tree skirts, table toppers, bed runners, and so forth

Beginner Quilt Adult: First quilt made by an adult.

Quilted Clothing: Must be quilted. Clothing is not eligible for Best of Show award.

Display Only Category: Quilts that are not being judged, only displayed.
