Jellyroll Strips

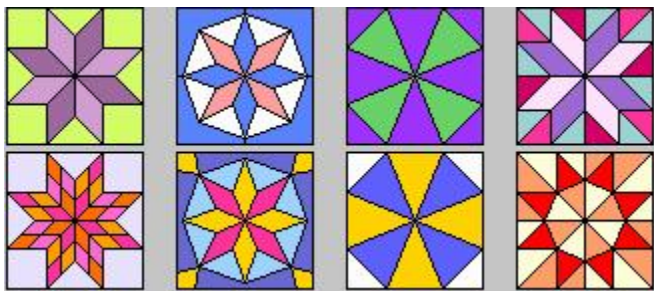

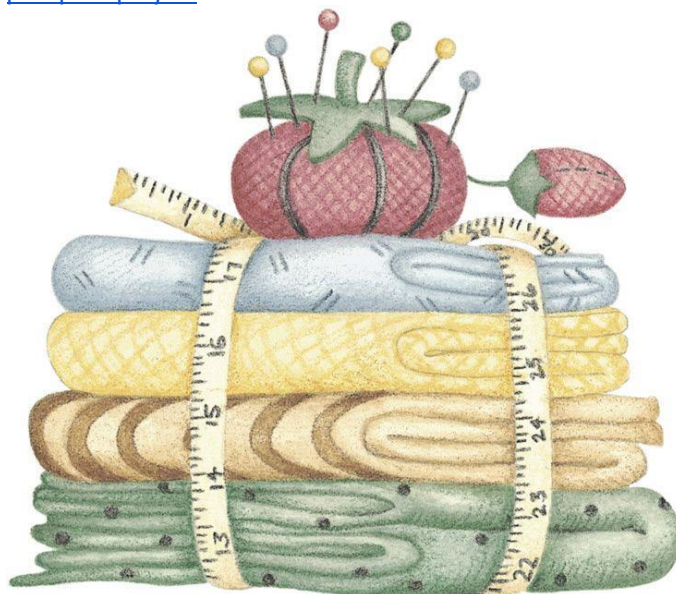
Note: Bloom Quilts in Margaretville, just a few miles past Arkville, will be open 10 am - 5 pm that day! :)
