

# BOUTIS- FRENCH QUILTING

## SUPPLY LIST

Front and backing Muslin or cotton batiste- enough to fit the pattern with 2 " around

Long Needle: Either one by Tulip- Boutis and Trapunto cording needle on Etsy/or; Dritz 5 inch doll making needle -Online at Jo- Ann, Walmart or Amazon; or (last choice)a Tapestry needle or Sashiko needle

Sewing needle with 30 wt cotton thread to match the fabric

Pins/ scissors/ toothpicks/safety basting pins

White acrylic worsted weight knitting yarn- one skein

Blue fabric marking pen or soft lead pencil

### Preparation before the workshop:

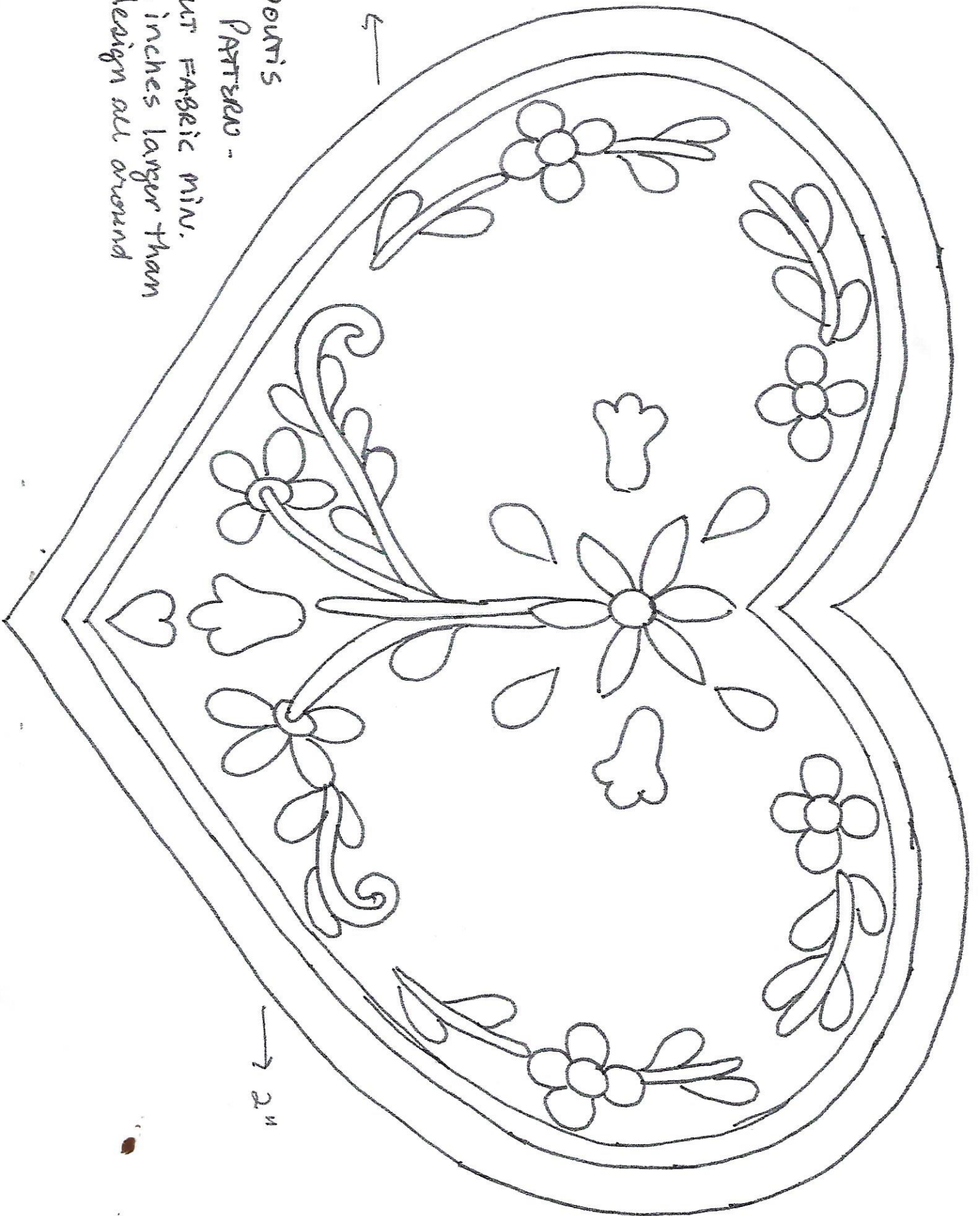
Cut fabric for a front and back-enough to fit the design of choice with at least 2 inches all around. On the back fabric (on it's right side) trace the pattern with either the blue marking pen or the lead pencil. This can be done using a light box or tape the pattern and fabric onto a window to trace. Next pin or baste the front and back fabric (with the design on it) WRONG sides together. That's it!
