

JELLY ROLL RUG/PLACEMATS

Class is February 2019 after the guild meeting.

- You will need:**
- 2½” strips of fabric. (Jelly Roll)**
 - 2 ½” strips of cotton batting (Bosal)**
 - Jeans needle**
 - Machine that will zigzag**
 - Walking foot is very helpful**
 - Thread to match**
 - At least two wound bobbins**
 - Small sharp pointed scissors**
 - General sewing tools**

Bring a
power cord
and a
cushion.
Also a lite
lunch.

If you want you can cut your own fabric and batting strips:

Before coming to class, sew a few of the Jelly Roll strips together on the diagonal. Fold or roll neatly for easy carrying to class.

Trim seams to ¼” and press seams open.

You can get 14 strips from 1 yard of fabric. You DO NOT need to sew batting strips together if you cut your own.

FYI: Small oval rug (17 X 33) 20 strips

Small rectangle rug (17 X31) 20 strips

Medium oval (30 X44) 40 strips
