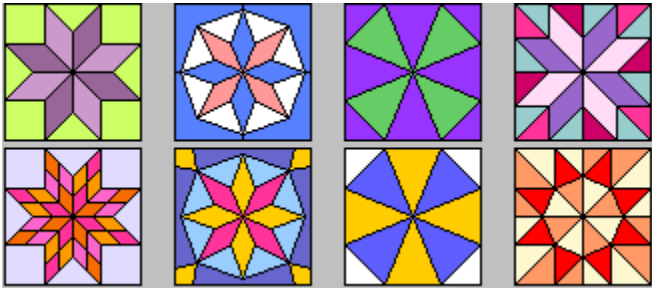

CHARM SQUARES

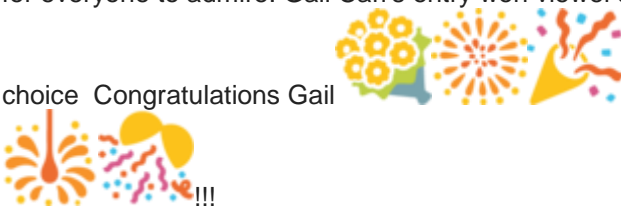
