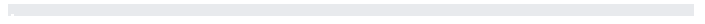
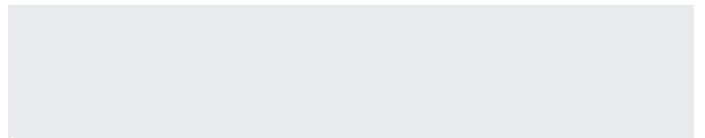


Twin Quilt Charity Quilt Project
