FULL CLASS DESCRIPTION:

A fun Halloween Pillow (doesn't have to be Halloween) made with the Dresden Ruler to create funky Halloween Houses out of a variety of Halloween Fabrics.

CLASS SUPPLIES:

10-15+ (more is always better) Halloween Fabrics (theme of your choice)

6 plus fabrics for roofs, windows, & doors

2-3 Sheets of Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 - double stick lite fusible web (Joann's) or Soft Fuse whatever you have on hand will do.

Backing for size of pillow 22" + 6" (28")

22" square of background to place houses on or 18" square with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch border fabric & 4) 2/12" squares for corners.

24" square batting and backing

24" piece of muslin

3 yds. of trim of your choice for outside of pillow

Bigger Perfect Circles by Karen Kay Buckley (order from Amazon or get from me)

Dresden Ruler 18* (Can order from Amazon, Missouri Star Quilt Company, or get from me.)

Cutting Mat

Ruler

Rotary Cutter

Basic Sewing Supplies
Small Iron and Ironing mat
Machine - in good working order

Optional: Can get 20 precut wedges from me for \$15 including shipping. You will still need to buy background fabric for pillow front and back. Back of pillow can be different than the front. Buy 1 ½ yards if using same on front and back. I sometimes used a fat quarter for the front and add 21/2" border to make 22" top for pillow. Also you will need to rob your stash for windows and doors.

If cutting your own fabrics, it would be helpful if your wedges were cut out prior to class. All 20 wedges should be cut 7 ½ inches tall. *It's important to be accurate in cutting wedges.
