Supplies: 4 coordinating fabrics

1 for front pocket, 1 for back pocket, both cut to 14x18

1 for front and 1 for back, both cut to 18x18

16 inches sew on Velcro (optional)

4 ties about 11 inches long

Instructions:

- 1- fold and press each pocket fabric in half wrong sides together
- 2- fold and press the front and back pieces in half, creating a top and bottom
- 3- on the front piece, pin each pocket to the raw edges opposite the center fold
- 4- make 4 ties
- 5- on the front fabric, pin 2 ties 2/12 inches down from the center fold on both the left and the right
- 6- on the right side of the back fabric, mark a 16 inch line parallel with the fold 1 1/2 inches from both bottom edges, use this line to sew on the Velcro, one piece on each bottom edge
- 7- pin the back fabric wrong side up to the top of the pinned front piece, keeping the ties between both fabrics
- 8- leaving an area for turning, sew 1/4inch around all 4 sides
- 9- turn right side out, press and sew the opening closed
- 10- sew dividers in each pocket
