CMQHOF will be raffling off a quilt at the show. The quilt is a *Delectable Mountain pattern* in burgundy and white. Several of you contributed blocks last fall which was greatly appreciated.

All of the member quilt guilds are obliged to sell raffle tickets for this quilt. Raffle tickets will be available at the WQG meeting in June for you to either sell or purchase. Please see Nora at the meeting. If you cannot make the meeting please contact Nora.

#### MINIATURE HISTORICAL QUILTING GROUP


The Miniature Historical Quilt Group will meet Saturday, June 1st at 10:00 am on Zoom. Pat will open the meeting at 9:30 for socializing.


There will be a lecture about a woman who created an American holiday and then waged a life long campaign against it.


We will also be discussing plans for next year—themes, lectures and options for quilts (mini, block of the month, Dear Jane, etc.).

















# **BLOCK OF THE MONTH** *May 2024*

# **FOLKLORE**

We will make a 10 ½" pieced and unfinished block Which appeared in Fon's & Porter's Love of Quilting Jan/Feb 2010 on pp. 48-52. It was designed by Kim Schaefer.



READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. MAKE A PRACTICE BLOCK FIRST...

All seams are 14"

FABRICS: 1) Black floral: 45/8" square(Provided from Grace Moone from her mother's fabrics)


- 2) Black tone-on-tone or solid: two rectangles, 2" x 4 5/8", two rectangles 2" x 7 5/8"
- 3) Brightly colored rectangles ranging in width from 1" to 2" and four of each in the lengths of:
- 9", 7", 5", 3" at least. You can use a variety of scraps in purples, pinks, or greens OR you can

use one color family( for ex. all purples)


**Block Assembly** 

- 1) Choose two 9" rectangles, two 7" rectangles, two 5" rectangles and two 3" rectangles. Join together as shown and press in one direction. This unit needs to be at least 8 3/8" in width.
- 2) Place a 5 7/8" square template or ruler atop this unit and draw around the template or cut using a square-up ruler. Cut this square in half diagonally.

HANDLE THIS BLOCK CAREFULLY SINCE EDGES ARE CUT ON THE BIAS.....



- 3) On opposite sides of the 4  $\frac{7}{8}$ " square, place a black 2" x 4 5/8" rectangle and stitch. Press to the black. On the other pair of opposite sides, place the 2 " x 7 5/8" rectangles and stitch. Press to the black to make a "frame". Square up to 7  $\frac{7}{8}$ "
- 4) Join two corner triangle units made in #1, & #2 to opposite sides of the frame as shown. Press to the triangle unit. Then take the second pair of triangle units and attach to the other pair of opposite sides and press to the triangle units.
- 5) SQUARE UP TO 10 %" AND SIGN YOUR NAME IN THE SEAM ALLOWANCE. Bring to the June meeting or mail to Mary McLaughlin at 212 Dogwood Lane, Kingston, NY 12401








Corner Unit Diagrams
